**Findings:** We surveyed this cataloged stream up to its ponded headwaters using a backpack electrofisher and GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon. This is a narrow stream, approximately 2-4 ft wide, that has steady flowing water with a large pond acting as its source (Table 1; Figures 1–3).

**Recommendations:** Extend upper extent of Stream No. 191-20-13800-2016-3151-4021-5031 in the anadromous waters catalog (Figure 4).
