EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon from five to 10 fish in all waters of the Wood River drainage. The bag and possession limit for other salmon, except king and sockeye salmon, remains at five fish. The limit for salmon, other than king and sockeye salmon, is in combination with the more liberal limits for sockeye salmon.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 67.022(h)(5) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Tuesday June 30 through 11:59 p.m. Thursday, December 31, 2026:


5 AAC 67.022. Special provisions for the seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means in the Bristol Bay Area.

(h) In the Wood River drainage, the following special provisions apply:

(5) the bag and possession limit for salmon, other than king salmon, is 10 fish with no size limit; of which only five per day and five in possession may be chum, pink or coho salmon in combination;

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement of sockeye salmon in the Wood River is projected to exceed the escapement goal of 700,000 – 1,800,000 fish. Through June 28, 2026, a total of 1,215,372 sockeye salmon have been counted at the Wood River tower. Since the escapement is projected to exceed the escapement goal it is warranted to increase the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon in the Wood River sport fishery.
